Application/Proposal Format:

The applicants should strictly follow the format suggested in the guidelines. An application that does not adhere to the guidelines will not be reviewed for the award.

Application/Proposal Review and Evaluation:

All fellowship applications will be reviewed and evaluated by a committee of qualified experts in the field of the proposed research. Based on the reviewers' comments and evaluation, the ASNEng Awards, Grants, and Scholarship Committee will select the winner for the award and submit its recommendation to the Executive Committee of the Society for the final approval.
