The Society has been officially incorporated as a non-profit organization. At this time, work is in progress to apply for the federal tax exempt 501(c)(3) organization status.

Objectives and Purposes

The objective of the Society is to promote professional advancement of individuals with Nepalese background /connection and friends of Nepal who have expertise and training in any branch of engineering or in related scientific and technical fields that lend support to engineering. The goal of the Society is also to help promote engineering and technological advancement in Nepal.

The Purposes of the Society are as below:

- (a). To bring together Nepalese and friends of Nepal, who are in engineering fields and/or who are in other technical and scientific professions closely related to engineering, for exchange of ideas and professional interaction.
- (b). To empower Nepalese engineers and scientists with a sense of pride and achievement through technical conferences, seminars and workshops.
- (c) To help in and advocate for the technological advancement and modernization of the infrastructure in Nepal.
- (d) To help strengthen the capability of Nepalese engineers and professionals in areas closely related to engineering by fostering and encouraging local, national, and international collaboration with researchers, academicians, and practitioners worldwide.

(e) Promote and encourage professional interaction and lifelong learning among members.

(f) To recognize outstanding contributions of individuals and organizations.

(g) Provide advice for public, corporate and government policy making bodies in matter of broad concern to Society members and to areas of engineering and scientific development and needed and as appropriate.

(h) To promote, mobilize resources, and facilitate the advancement of engineering and scientific education, research, training, practice and technology transfer in Nepal through various symposia, seminar and workshops, and other possible means, including collaboration with other organizations.

Membership Grades and Qualification.

Membership in the Society is open to all people with Nepalese background/connection and friends of Nepal who have degree in an engineering field or in a closely related technical/scientific area that support and enhance the profession of engineering through education, practice, and research. The voting membership grades of the Society are Member, Senior Member, and Fellow. The non-voting membership grade of the Society is Student Member.

Student Member:

To be eligible for the grade of Student Member, an individual shall be enrolled at least half-time in a 4-year undergraduate program or at least half-time in a graduate program in any branch of engineering.

Member:

To be eligible for the grade of Member, an individual shall:

Criterion 1: have been graduated with a bachelor's degree in engineering or closely related scientific/technical field; OR.

Criterion 2: have been graduated with a graduate degree in engineering or closely related scientific/technical field; OR.

Criterion 3. have been graduated with an associate degree in engineering AND has 3 years of professional experience in engineering.
