

Merit Award for Students

Application Guidelines and Criteria

The information provided in this form and supporting documents will be used by the American Society of Nepalese Engineers (ASNEngr) Awards, Grants and Scholarships (AGS) Committee for the application review and award selection process.

To qualify for this award, a student applicant must meet the following eligibility criteria and qualification requirements:

- ✓ The student must be enrolled full-time in an undergraduate program in an accredited engineering/science college or university in Nepal and be in his/her freshman (1st) year of study.
- ✓ The applicant must be an individual of Nepalese origin/descent/heritage. The applicant is required to submit certified/notarized copy of two (2) of the following official documents :Nepali Citizenship, Birth Certificate (VDC, District Offices, Municipalities) or a copy of Nepali Passport picture page.
- ✓ The student applicant must be ranked highest among those enrolled in all engineering fields in the merit/admission list of the entrance examination held by the university.
- ✓ The female applicant must be ranked highest among female applicants enrolled in all engineering fields in the merit/admission list of the entrance examination held by the university. Only one female student among all the universities will be awarded with “Merit Award for Student”.
