Application Guidelines and Criteria

The American Society of Nepalese Engineers (ASNEng) calls for applications for the 2026 Merit Awards for Students in USA. The ASNEng Merit Awards for Nepalese Students in the USA are designed to recognize and support undergraduate students of Nepalese origin pursuing degrees in Engineering, Technology, Computer Science, Information Technology, and related fields at accredited U.S. universities or community colleges. Eligibility criteria: Full-time undergraduate student with a minimum GPA of 3.0

Application Requirements: Applicants must submit the following materials:

- a) Application form
- b) Personal Essay (maximum 1000 words): Describe your career goals, community service aspirations, extracurricular activities, and financial needs.
- c) Proof of Nepalese origin (ancestry or hereditary) such as Nepali passport of the applicant or his/her parents, or a letter of reference by an ASNEng member.
- d) Proof of full-time university/community college enrollment in the U.S. Unofficial progress report or transcripts from the college are valid in case the official transcripts are not available.
- e) Reference letter from an academic advisor or professor.

Number of Awards and Amount: Two (2) Annual Awards of \$1,000 for the year 2026

The number of awards and amount may vary year to year depending on the availability of the funds and the number of applicants.

Operations:

- a) The ASNEng Executive Committee will allocate the annual fund
- b) Awards, Grants, and Scholarships Committee will administer the award on behalf of the Society
